21 he has no *firm* root in himself, but is
only temporary, and when affliction or
persecution arises because of the word,
immediately he falls away.

22 "And the one on whom seed was sown
among thorns, this is the man who hears the
word, and the worry of the world and the
deceitfulness of wealth choke him, and it
becomes unfruitful.

23 "And the one on whom seed was sown on
the good soil, this is the man who hears the
word and understands it; who indeed bears
fruit and brings forth, some a hundredfold,
some sixty, and some thirty."

24 Jesus presented another parable to them,
saying, "The kingdom of heaven may be
compared to a man who sowed good seed in his
field.

But while his men were sleeping, his enemy
came and sowed tares among the wheat, and
went away.

26 "But when the wheat sprouted and bore
grain, then the tares became evident also.

27 "The slaves of the landowner came and said
to him, 'Sir, did you not sow good seed in your
field? How then do tares have tares?'

44 "The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure

again; and from joy over it he goes and sells all
that he has and buys that field.

merchant seeking fine pearls,
